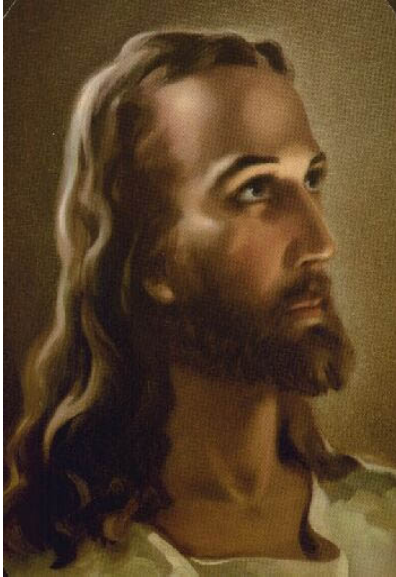


Lesson 2 You Can Be A New Person in Christ
